GH Chamber Government Affairs Committee Meeting

Representatives from the following gov't offices reports:

County Supervisor Barger:

- Motion to make it easier to help homeless individuals that are in no condition to care for themselves be admitted to a care facility
- Calling in Republic Trash services to explain customer's complaints

Assemblyman Acosta:

- Sponsoring and supporting bills for privacy laws
- Assuring funds remain available for foster youth programs
- Town hall meeting April 1st in Northridge

Councilman Englander:

- Working to have a reasonable geographic balance of businesses in the new Cannabis industry
- Sidewalk vending ordinance should have an opt-out provision for areas like CD12 that have expressed an opposition to them. Councilman is against state bill SB946 that would allow street vending in cities that don't have a licensing program
- Supports city motion to protect against cyber attacks

- Waiting for results of this year's first round of the Academic Decathlon championship
- Funding for the Career Tech program- one of very few schools with this program
