Representatives from the following gov't offices reports:

- Assemblyman Acosta (38): ab2725 bill; training construction skill program targeting teens with criminal records; Coffee with Acosta Tuesday, March 20th
- Granada Hills west of Balboa is in Bocanegra's district (39) vacant due to resigning
- Senator Hertzberg (18) working on bills to establish Bank of California; Bail reform and another attempt on a bill to tax services
- Committee Based motion to oppose a new bill AB 2731 that would impose an additional 17% tax of an individual's taxable income that is derived from investment management services interest
- Jarrod from Sup Barger: natural gas supplies and use of Aliso Canyon;
- Chris from Republic Services/Sunshine Canyon landfill- odor complaints down; 3.7" of rain no problems with runoff; gave statistics of methane capture, burn off and feed to storage supplies
